Pupil Premium Funding

The [pupil premium](#) is additional funding given to publicly funded schools in England to raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils and close the gap between them and their peers.

Pupil premium funding is available to both mainstream and non-mainstream schools, such as special schools and pupil referral units.

Funding for 2015.2016 is made up of the following elements:

In the 2015.2016 financial year, schools will receive the following funding for each **child registered as eligible for free school meals at any point in the last 6 years:**

- £1,320 for primary-aged pupils

Schools will also receive £1,900 for each **looked-after pupil** who:

- has been looked after for 1 day or more
- was adopted from care on or after 30 December 2005, or left care under:
 - a special guardianship order
 - a residence order

Schools will also receive £300 for pupils of parents in the armed forces.
