

Car Park Agreement

The School have an annual agreement with the Village Hall which allows us to use their car park.

The terms are as follows:

- 1) We need to park on tarmac and not park or pass on the grass verges as you enter the car park. We've put together a map to help highlight the areas we need to avoid.
- 2) We cannot use the car park when the Village Hall is booked. Instead we need to park in the village or on the cricket field. The School will be given a weeks notice and you will be informed via the school App (please download and switch on the notifications, it's fab).
- 3) In the very unlikely event that a Village Hall user is parked in the car park at the same time as us, we need to check that they don't mind us blocking them in.
- 4) We do not have a set time to leave the car park, we just need to leave as quickly as possible.
- 5) No parking down Shutts land on Thursdays - the bin lorry can't to the village hall to empty the bins.

This isn't part of the terms but is worth mentioning, to fit everyone in we need to make use of all available spaces (check out the map). There are times when cars will be blocked in, if you need to make a quick escape then parking down Shutts Lane is advised. If you need to block in other cars then please return to your car asap so we can get things flowing quickly. No one likes to be blocked or to block, it's just unavoidable as we don't have the space to turn to exit and more often than not another parent is entering the car park behind you, so you're kinda trapped!

We've had a few issues in the past 24 months which did cause our license to be reduced to 6 months, I'm pleased to say that this is now resolved and we now have good communication between ourselves and the Village Hall Committee.

Moving forward we have agreed that we all will handle any situations/timing conflicts in a polite and helpful manner, most our interaction are positive, that said, should you find yourself in a situation that is not polite and helpful then please escalate to the school.

Sorry this is a long one, it's not as bad as it sounds and compared to other local school we are very lucky, please shout if you have any questions.
