

Democracy

- Covered in Coram Education PSHE lessons: Me and My Relationships, Valuing Difference, Keeping Myself Safe, Rights and Responsibilities, Being My Best and Growing and Changing
- Voting for favourite reading books
- Children nominate others or themselves, then vote for children to sit on School Council etc
- KS 2 discuss relevant national and global democratic events such as elections or significant changes to laws
- Discussed in RE lessons when studying different religious practices
- Cross curricular coverage – Geography & Science – physical and human processes affected by democracy, English – texts cover democratic processes, History – democratic processes that have been affected by historical events and people
- Rules, sanctions and rewards voted on throughout the school, in classes, which the pupils discuss and take ownership of
- Debating activities in Year 5 & 6
- Pupil survey each year to gain children's views on learning and the environment

Tolerance of those of Different Faiths and Beliefs

- Covered in Coram Education PSHE lessons: Me and My Relationships, Valuing Difference, Keeping Myself Safe, Rights and Responsibilities, Being My Best and Growing and Changing
- Discussed in RE lessons where different religions are studied and valued
- Cross curricular coverage – Geography & Science – physical and human processes are affected by our faiths and beliefs, English – texts cover different faiths and beliefs, History – historical events that have been affected by faiths and beliefs of events and people, Art and Design – faiths and beliefs are represented throughout the Art and Design curriculum
- Pupils of different faiths and beliefs are supported in school when needed eg dietary requirements, Ramadan etc

Rule of Law

- RE – discuss laws within different religions
- School Behaviour Policy discussed with adults and children and used with the children at class and whole school level
- Children understand the rules, sanctions and reward systems within the school, both inside and outside
- Cross curricular coverage – Geography & Science - physical and human processes are affected by rule of law, English – texts cover rule of law, History – how the rule of law has been affected by both events and people in the past
- Specific school Values of Commitment, Belief, Bravery and School Vision part '...Run and no grow weary' reflects on this

Mutual Respect

- Covered in Coram Education PSHE lessons: Me and My Relationships, Valuing Difference, Keeping Myself Safe, Rights and Responsibilities, Being My Best and Growing and Changing
- RE lessons cover respect through learning about different faiths
- Class Diary of Reflection work
- Cross curricular coverage – Geography & Science – physical and human processes relate to respect and understanding, English – texts cover different elements of respect and understanding, History – events and people in the past related to respect and understanding, Music – respect and understanding for different traditions and music
- Rules, sanctions and rewards used throughout the school and discussed with the children
- Using restorative justice when appropriate to help children solve issues or disputes
- Debating activities in Y5 and Y6
