## **School Uniform**

Please name all items of clothing with your child's name and remove old names in second hand clothing. Glasses to be carried in a proper case, which is named. Shoes to be "sensible" with flat soles and preferably black, brown or navy blue. During the colder weather, girls are able to wear boots that are "sensible" with flat soles in black, brown or navy blue.

Wellington Boots are required for all different reasons during the school week. In winter and wetter months, they are used daily for playtimes. Therefore, please ensure a pair of named wellies live in school.

The wearing of jewellery is not permitted on safety grounds except for watches (unless these cause a distraction from learning for your child). Children with pierced ears should wear studs or sleepers but these should be removed for P.E. on the grounds of safety. Children need to be able to remove their own studs or sleepers for PE sessions.
