VALUE FOR LIFE

This week our focus has been MAKING A DIFFERENCE relating to our core value of COMMITMENT. DIARY DATES

As a reminder to the diary dates issued early in the academic year, the last day of school will be Wednesday 23rd. However, due to COVID-19 regulations there will be a staggered collection as follows:

- YR = 1.30pm (those in YR with siblings in Y6 can stay till 2pm)
- Y1 = 1.45pm
- Y6 = 2pm
- Keyworker = 3.15
- Teatime club = 3.45

• If you have children in school across these then choose the earliest time or 2pm if one of those is Y6

School Term dates for 2020/21 are below (and a Wiltshire PDF was sent out this week)

T1 = 1/9/20 to 21/10/20 but closed for INSET on Tues 1/9/20, Wed 2/9/20, Mon 19/10/20, Tues 20/10/20 and Wed 21/10/20

- T2 = 2/11/20 to 18/12/20
- T3 = 4/1/21 to 12/2/21
- T4 = 22/2/21 to 1/4/21
- T5 = 19/4/21 to 28/5/21
- T6 = 7/6/21 to 23/7/21

This means that the first day of school in September will be Thursday 3/9/20.

The school INSET days have been programmed at the start of the year for two reasons – both focused entirely on children and families:

- To enable staff to embed all adaptations to the 'new norm' as quickly as possible in order to maximise learning outcomes for children who may need to catch-up post lockdown
- To enable parents to take advantage of 2 full weeks in October to enjoy a family holiday that they may have missed this summer not effecting school attendance figures and hopefully cheaper for parents as well

END OF YEAR REPORTS

This Friday you will be emailed your child's End of Year Report. Whilst we may reference some of the wonderful homelearning achieved our assessments of pupils attainment and progress can only based on where they were before lockdown. Of course, all children would have achieved higher than this if Covid-19 had not struck. Similarly, the attendance figures are based on pre-lockdown records, but the average attendance should still have been in the region of 96%. Attendance below 90% is termed as persistent absence.

END OF YEAR CELEBRATIONS
