WELCOME BACK TO TERM 6 – ROUTINES

It is so wonderful to see all the children back together as one whole school bubble. Their delight at spending time with each other is so joyful to witness.

SPORTS DAY

Sports Day is planned for Monday 28th June, with the back-up wet weather sports day on Monday 5th of July. We have evolved this so it is slightly different to previous years in order to give more leadership opportunities to our older children.

Please can all children wear their PE kit that day but replacing their PE top for an appropriate t-shirt in the colour of their team (red, yellow, blue, green) – whilst we have new team bibs for interteam tournaments the children will be more comfortable in their own t-shirt.

On the 28th:

- In the morning children will take part in activities organised and led by Ash class. All children will score points for their team. Parents are not invited to this session.
- 12 noon parents are invited to attend from this time. We will hold a picnic on the school field for all pupils and parents together. Those booking hot dinners can eat theirs at tables we will put out, or parents can replace this with a packed lunch. Please let the school office know if you would like to cancel your child's school meal for this day.
- 1pm races will begin. Parents are invited.

- Races will be held in the morning as there is staff training in the afternoon. This will start at 9.30am and parents are invited

SUN SAFETY

Hopefully, we will have some lovely sunny weather in Term 6.

Please ensure each day in school:

- your child has a full water bottle
- your child has a sun-hat
- you have applied all day sun-cream / lotion to your child or your child has a named sun-cream dispenser with them that they can apply themselves (our staff are not allowed to apply sun-cream).

Our approach to school uniform in hot weather:

- we are fortunate in that our cotton shirts are by their very nature cooler than polo shirts
- if the weather gets too muggy staff will ask children to remove their ties and put them in their bags
- we are fortunate that on some days children come to school in their PE kit anyway so this will be naturally cooler
