On Friday, last week, Mr Wyatt and myself undertook a maths audit across the school. This presented an opportunity to capture an overview of maths across the school. We were able to observe lessons and learning and talk to the children about their views of maths in our school. It was a fabulous opportunity to evaluate how we are doing and to identify our strengths and some next steps. In the afternoon, our maths governor joined us for the pupil interviews. The children were amazing and shared their views of their learning in maths with us.

This week we have taken part in National Storytelling week. I was delighted to visit both Oak and Elm class on Monday to share a story with them. The story I chose to tell was called 'The Boy who cried Wolf'. It is an old favourite of mine that ignites a discussion with children about the importance of being truthful.




Friends of Coombe Bissett School


Well Done to everyone awarded a Team Point or Green Card, with particular Congratulations to Red House the winners this week with an amazing 261 points.
