Our class reader this term is 'Wonder' by R J Palacio and we will focus on expressing opinions and argument.

In our writing, we will be exploring the story of Beowulf to write our own 'Beating the Monster' story. Our non-fiction theme is recounts: chronological writing about an event or a visit.

PSHE

Our SCARF units this term are on the theme of Valuing Difference. The children will be celebrating difference, considering kindness and the difference it can make to everyone and also the influence of social media.

Maths

We will learn about statistics unit where we will gather data and record it in line graphs and, for the Year 6s, in pie charts. We will analyse the data and find the 'mean' amount.

We will then go on to recap on written methods multiplication and division — including how to convert remainders to decimals.

Science

Light

We will be learning about where light comes from, how light is reflected and that the angle of incidence is equal to the angle of reflection, refraction and how shadows are formed. As part of our project, we will make a periscope.

The Arts

We will be learning to play the *ukulele* with Gregory Cook.

Humanities
