Dear Parents/Carers,

This week I have reflected upon the support that parents/carers and the community provide for our school. This week, I led the collective worship on Monday afternoon, as Reverend Jenny was unable to join us. Several children helped me along to lead it following the 'Coombe Bissett' way and it was lovely. There was lots of laughter, as I shared a true life story of bravery about a ten year old boy who fought off a leopard (with his school bag and hands) to protect his sister on the way home from school. The children shared with me their own acts of bravery and it was impressive. The key message is that 'God is always alongside us and supporting us on the way'

I also felt this on Wednesday morning when I set off from home, there was no snow on the ground where I live, and so I was guided by others regarding the situation in Coombe Bissett. I did worry about any inconvenience caused, however, above all, the safety of our Coombe Bissett families and children took priority. It took some bravery and I trust that I made the right decision supported by key staff and the chair of governors. Closing a school, is never a decision taken lightly. It has indicated that we need some forward planning to ensure our pupils do not miss out if we have another occasion like Wednesday. I will be reviewing any remote provision for learning as a matter of urgency and will update you at the earliest opportunity regarding this.

The next Parents' Forum is on Tuesday 28th March on the subject of **'Safeguarding your child online'**, as a follow up to information that was shared via my newsletter during Internet Safety week. The Parents' Forum in April will focus on 'Behaviour'.

I'd like to thank parents/carers who attended the last session regarding attendance. We are introducing some rewards to recognise improved attendance and awards for children who have not missed a day this term.




