We learned about the artist Andy Goldsworthy who uses all kinds of materials from nature in his art, many of which are very temporary as they get washed away by the weather. We then made our own pieces of art using flowers and leaves. We loved arranging the petals into patterns and hammering them to release the natural dyes. We also enjoyed making leaf prints. After this we made some mobiles from sticks, pine cones, flowers, etc, which was great practise for tying knots. You might be able to spot them hanging on the fence at the end of the playground. In the afternoon we learnt how to do weaving, using a variety of different materials.
