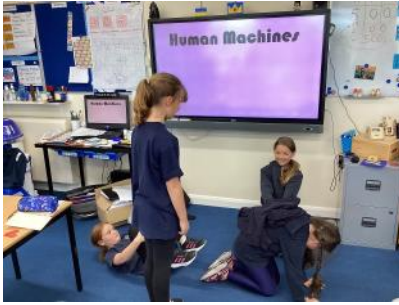
Elm Class



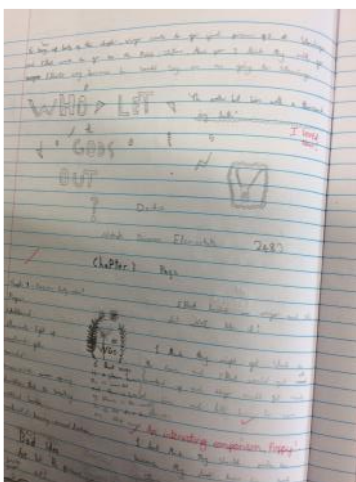
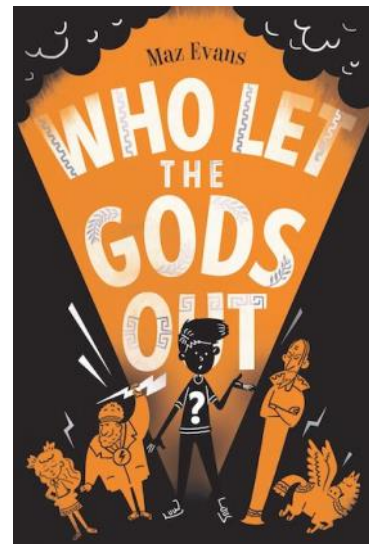
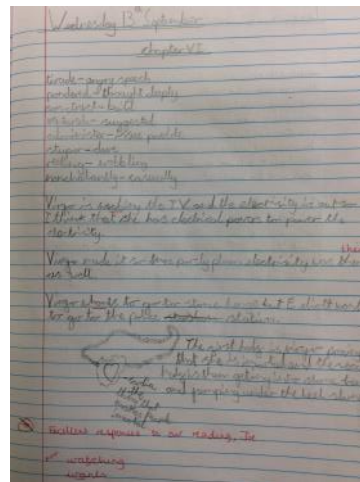
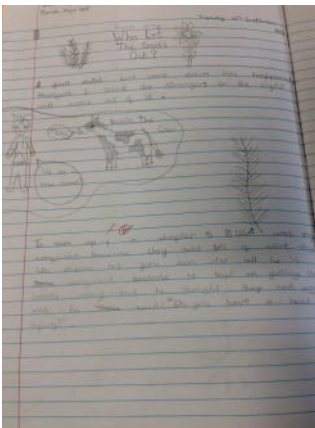
